## 5. Land Use, Land-Use Change, and Forestry

This chapter describes the methods applied to estimate state-level GHG fluxes resulting from land use and land-use change within states according to changes within and conversions between all land use types, including:

- Forest land,<sup>11</sup>
- Cropland,
- Grassland,
- Wetlands,
- Settlements, and
- Other land.

More information on national-level emissions and removals and associated methods is available in Chapter 6 of the national-level *GHGIA*.

### Methodology

Table 5-1 summarizes the different approaches used to estimate state-level LULUCF emissions and removals. Overall, the methods used to develop state-level estimates are consistent with those used in EPA (2024). For some categories, including forest carbon, cropland, grassland and some settlements categories, state and national estimates are both developed using the same underlying data and methods for portions or all of the time series. In these cases, state-level estimates are not derived by disaggregating the national-level *GHGIA* estimate to individual states. Rather, the national-level *GHGIA* methodology uses geographically detailed data to develop estimates that can be aggregated to both the state and national levels. These instances are noted in Table 5-1 as using the same methods as the national-level *GHGIA*. This designation indicates that state and national estimates are developed using the same underlying methods. For other categories, national-level *GHGIA* estimates are disaggregated or allocated to the state level using activity data or geographic proxies. State completeness is consistent with the national-level *GHGIA*; see Annex 1.

For users seeking a comprehensive technical understanding of the compilation of the *GHGIA by State* data, this methodology report is best read in conjunction with the corresponding sections of the three references provided in Table 5-2. The *GHGIA by State* emission and sink estimates are compiled to be consistent with the latest national-level *GHGIA* data and largely apply and extend methodologies and data previously published by EPA at the national and state levels. Methodological detail is only included in this document for new sources not included in EPA (2024). Unless otherwise noted, readers should refer to EPA (2024) for detailed descriptions of disaggregation methodologies. Where previously published methods remain unchanged, CGS summarizes the disaggregation approaches rather than repeating information from the latest national-level inventory report or the previous state-level methodology report. Recalculations at the national-level *GHGIA* that impact state-level estimates are discussed in the national-level *GHGIA* Chapter 6.

## Methodology for newly added sources

This section elaborates on methods for calculating sources and/or sinks included in the LULUCF sector that were not included or estimated in previous disaggregated data published by EPA (2024). For information on disaggregation methods for all other sources, the methodology outlined by EPA (2024) still applies, but in some cases were updated for different portions of the 1990–2024 time series, as described in Table 5-1.

*Forest Land Remaining Forest Land, Harvested Wood Products.* The methods to compile state-level carbon stock change estimates for harvested wood products (HWP) are based on the default data from the State Inventory Tool (SIT) (CGS, 2026) and then scaled to match the national HWP carbon flux totals in the national-level *GHGIA* (Desai et al., 2026), consistent with data from Walters et al. (2026). The default data from SIT come from 1987, 1992, and 1997 Forest Service data to estimate average annual stock change for the time period between 1990–1992, 1993–1997, and 1998 to present. These average annual stock change estimates by state were then scaled to the national estimates from the national-level *GHGIA* based on the relative proportion of those state SIT estimates to total aggregated (national-level) SIT estimates. SIT only provides total wood products estimates and does not disaggregate by HWP as products in use and products in solid waste disposal sites (SWDS). To disaggregate HWP to these two subcategories, the proportion of these two categories to the national HWP total from the national-level *GHGIA* was applied equally across all states; changes to the relative proportion of HWP products in use and products in SWDS are reflected at the state level across the 1990 through present time series.

*Forest Land Remaining Forest Land, Nitrogen Additions to Forest Soils.* Nitrogen additions to forest soils are estimated by taking the total from the national-level *GHGIA* and allocating those emissions evenly to states in the Southeastern U.S., Washington, and Oregon. These are the states included in the nitrogen additions estimates from EPA (2025), reflecting those southeastern states with pine plantations and states with commercial Douglas-fir stands in the Pacific Northwest.

*Coastal Wetlands Remaining Coastal Wetlands, N<sub>2</sub>O Emissions from Aquaculture.* Estimates were disaggregated from the national-level *GHGIA* total using a proxy approach. State-level aquaculture production was estimated using the USDA Census of Aquaculture for the five available census years (USDA, 1998; 2005; 2013; 2018; and 2023). Food-size aquaculture sales data were extracted for the ten highest-volume aquaculture species reported in NOAA's annual national production summaries (see national-level *GHGIA* methodology for more information on the use of NOAA for national activity data): catfish, trout, tilapia, striped bass, oysters, clams, shrimp, mussels, crawfish and salmon. For states where sales data were withheld, state-level sales were estimated by applying the state's farm proportion of national farms to the reported national sales for that species. Once all state sales values were either reported or estimated, each state's proportion of the national sales total was calculated and multiplied by the corresponding national annual production (in pounds) for that species to estimate state-level production. The remaining years in the time series, for which USDA Census of Aquaculture data were not available, were estimated by applying each state's proportion of national production from the more recent available census year to the corresponding national annual production estimates.

## Comparison to national totals

Quality control procedures were implemented to review changes to the time series and confirm state-level LULUCF estimates. Issues identified during these checks were addressed, and errors were corrected (e.g., computational formula errors, transcription errors, etc.).

The state-level LULUCF calculations include estimates of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions from drained organic soils, which resulted in GHG estimates that generally align with total estimates in the national-level *GHGIA* but present small differences. Furthermore, independent rounding of the state-level estimates also presents small differences between the total state-level estimates and the national-level *GHGIA*.

## Future areas for improvement

Areas for improving state-level estimates are the same as those presented in Section 6.1 of the national-level *GHGIA* (Desai et al., 2026), including improvement of geographic completeness, given that many state-level LULUCF category estimates utilize the same methodological approach as the national-level *GHGIA*. Some state-level planned improvements for LULUCF include:

- Improving state-level estimates to HWP based on ongoing research.
- Refining the coastal wetlands aquaculture approach to reflect only coastal states, which requires revisiting USDA and NOAA data, as well as the national aquaculture N<sub>2</sub>O estimation approach.
- Better integrating data between waste sector landfills and LULUCF sector landfilled yard trimming and food scraps, to potentially leverage activity data and ensure consistency across sectors.
- Implementing a new cropland and grassland soil carbon stock change modeling framework, leveraging publicly available cropland and grassland spatial extent and management information.

- Revising the grassland fire non-CO<sub>2</sub> emission estimation framework by leveraging the [Wildland Fire Emissions Inventory System \(v2.2025.10\)](#).
